Funding and Session Times

Children can join our Pre-School as soon as they turn three years old. We operate flexible start dates, please discuss this with the school.

Funding

All children receive a number of funded hours, this funding begins the term **after** the child turns three. Prior to this you can pay for your sessions. The minimum entitlement is 15 hours of free childcare, and our Pre-School is a great place to spend those hours! Some families are entitled to a full 30 hours (all day Monday to Friday, 9.00am-3.00pm) of funded sessions. If you are only entitled to the 15 hours, you can pay for additional sessions. If your child uses their 15 free hours in another setting, you can pay for additional sessions with us. Please note that our setting will take priority of your funded hours over private settings. Early Years at Moggerhanger Primary School Chicks (Pre-School) and Robins (Reception)

At Moggerhanger Primary School we are extremely proud of our Early Years setting, which comprises of Reception and Pre-School, both of which have exceptionally small class sizes. The kind and dedicated teaching staff work hard to create a warm and stimulating environment where learning is fun, and the children are at the heart of everything we do.

Our Reception and Pre-School are a fully integrated part of the school, giving your child the opportunity to benefit from an extensive range of facilities in our primary school setting, such as a large, well-equipped playground, field, Forest School area and traditional school hall. Our Pre-School and Reception each have their own

connecting classroom, and are able to free-flow through both rooms and share a designated outdoor area during their child-initiated time.

The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

In Pre-School we follow the Early Years Foundation Stage guidance, learning through play and playful teaching, both inside and outside, whatever the weather. Your child will also start to do things like recognise and write their and develop own name their communication, literacy and numeracy skills through a combination of adult-led and childled activities.

We place a high emphasis on outdoor learning. The children have continuous access to a high quality outdoor learning environment, and also have a dedicated 'Forest School' time once a week where they explore the wider school grounds.



The four guiding principles shape our practice. These are: Principles of the EYFS Every child is a unique child, who is constantly learning and can be resilient, capable, confident and Children learn to be strong and independent through positive relationships Children learn and develop environments, in which their experiences respond to their individual needs and there is a strong partnership between practitioners and parents and/or well in enabling carers Children develop and learn in different ways and at different rates.

Uniform

Uniform is not compulsory in Pre-School, however we would ask that your child is dressed appropriately for the setting and would request your child has the following items:

- Closed, sturdy footwear
- A hooded coat
- Wellies at school
- Sun hat
- Water bottle

If you wish, you can purchase the Moggerhanger Primary School uniform, which is a grey skirt, shorts or trousers, white or navy polo top, navy cardigan or jumper. Please see the information on our website if you would like to purchase items with the school logo.





Morning Snack

The children have a designated snack time during the morning session. We provide a variety of healthy and tasty snacks for the children. This provides opportunities to learn about healthy choices, as well as being a valuable time to sit together and develop social skills.

The school office will be able to provide you with more information about the voluntary contribution we ask for towards snack.

Lunch Time

If your child attends for the full day session, they will have lunch at school in their Pre-School classroom.

You can provide a packed lunch from home— please remember we have a strict NO NUTS policy due to serious allergies. You also have the option of booking a

We ask that your child has a named water bottle at school every day, but we are always happy to provide a cup if they forget.
