Cancellation of Events and Parent Consultations

At Moggerhanger Primary School we are taking the Coronavirus pandemic very seriously. I would like to reassure you that we are following the daily/updated guidelines from Public Health England and the Department for Education. We are continuing to reinforce the importance of handwashing and hygiene with the children, as they are now expected to wash their hands at regular intervals throughout the day.

I am sorry to inform you that we have taken the decision to cancel all parent consultations, Easter celebrations, parent information sessions, school visits and swimming sessions planned for the rest of this term with immediate effect. I know that some of you will be disappointed and your children may be upset that these things are not taking place, but we feel it is a necessary method to reduce the spread of the virus and to try and keep our children and staff as safe as possible.

We have produced our own contingency plan as a school and are working with teachers to ensure work is being prepared and will be available in the event we are instructed to close.

We ask that if a child develops symptoms, however mild, you should: Self-isolate following government recommendations, which is currently seven days, avoid contact with other people immediately and call NHS 111 if necessary. You do not need to follow this advice if you have no symptoms.

If your child is taken unwell at school with Coronavirus-like symptoms, then we will need to send them home. Please refer to our website and social media platforms for regular updates. We will continue to keep you updated as and when any new information arises. If you have any concerns or questions, please do not hesitate to make contact.
