Smoking

Sandy Secondary School and Moggerhanger Primary School are non-smoking sites. This includes the building and grounds and applies to all staff, students and visitors. This also applies to students whilst on school trips.

Cigarettes, as with non-medically prescribed drugs, are banned items for students. Students caught smoking will be issued with an SLT detention and parents will be informed.

Further offences may lead to isolation and/or fixed term exclusion.

<u>Alcohol</u>

We believe that alcohol has no place in an educational setting. This includes the building and grounds and applies to all staff, students and visitors. It also applies to both staff and students on educational trips. Therefore, it is our expectation that alcohol will not be consumed on the site during the school day or on any school trips.

At the end of term or year, if there is a staff party onsite, the school will not provide alcohol; if the bar is open staff may purchase drinks if they so wish or bring their own. (The school takes no responsibility for any adult should they make the decision to drive home after consuming alcohol).

Alcohol is a banned item for students. Students caught in the possession of alcohol, who consume it on the premises or who present as under the influence of alcohol will be dealt with as stated in our Drugs Incident Policy.

This policy is not applicable to social events. If it is a mixed staff and student event all staff should drink moderately.
